Thank you to Mr. Burl and the Jacksonville Community Center for helping us head up our swimming program.

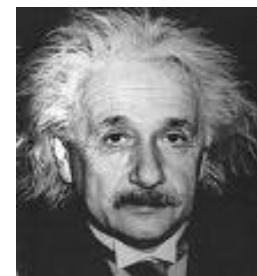
