Timeline and general description of services:

In accordance with the requirements outlined in the "REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL FOR A PREPLATED MEALS PROGRAM FISCAL YEAR 2012", Preferred Meals Systems, Inc. ("Preferred Meals") agrees to provide pre-plated meals, consumable supplies and the necessary equipment, training and documentation, such as product nutrition guides and HACCP or food service operation to the Jacksonville Lighthouse Charter School –Flightline Campus (JLCS-FL), effective July 1, 2011 and ending June 30, 2012 with a possibility of 4 (4) one-year renewals. The price per cold breakfast is \$1.37; breakfast-to-go is \$1.4042; hot breakfast is \$1.46; lunch is \$2.38; and a snack is \$0.75. PBLCS will serve breakfast, lunch and snacks and maintains its right to change the type of meal service based on the needs of its student population.

Preferred Meals agrees to provide meal service in accordance with the Lighthouse Academies Wellness Policy (see Exhibit E on the RFP). Preferred Meal menus will use Group IV Traditional Meal Patterns for each grade level. Furthermore, Preferred Meals agrees that menus will have less than 30% of calories from fat and 10% of calories from saturated fat as dictated by the United States Department of Agriculture ("USDA"). Preferred Meals shall provide menus to the JLCS-FL two weeks prior to the beginning of each month so that the school's wellness committee can review menus and respond to Preferred Meals with any necessary changes. All substitutions, should there be any, must be in compliance with the Wellness Policy and USDA requirements with advanced notice provided to the JLCS-FL.

In addition, JLCS-FL and Preferred Meals agree to the following

1. Preferred Meals guarantees complete satisfaction with its services hereunder.
2. Preferred Meals will issue invoices weekly. Payment terms are net invoice amount within thirty (30) days of the invoice date.
3. Notwithstanding any of the foregoing items and conditions, in the event that either party, in the exercise of its reasonable judgment, is not satisfied with the other's performance under this contract such party shall have the right to terminate this Agreement upon thirty (30) days prior written notice.
4. All information provided by Preferred Meals is considered to be confidential and proprietary. This information cannot be divulged without prior written approval of Preferred Meals.
5. This contract shall be considered fully executed once the parties have signed this contract and has been approved by the Lighthouse Academies of Arkansas, Inc. Board and the Arkansas Department of Education, Division of School and Community Nutrition Programs.
6. Preferred Meals will provide training to food personnel to ensure proper food presentation, safe meal preparation and handling, and appropriate equipment management.
7. Preferred Meals will review equipment inventory needs and provide necessary equipment requested by JLCS-FL that will allow the kitchen staff to operate an efficient meals program. The additional equipment will be delivered within two weeks of the request.
8. All equipment supplied by Preferred Meals must meet the state department of health inspections and must maintain the specified temperature range of what the equipment is intended. If any equipment needs maintenance Preferred Meals will immediately service the equipment
