The Principal's newsletter will be supplemented by newsletter created by every homeroom teacher.
- JLCS will hold at least two (2) Information Nights for parents August 9th, 11th – in addition to a formal Open House to be held August 12, 2011 – to explain the school's Title I program the facilitator will be Principal, Delano Whitfield for question you may contact him at (501)985-1200 and to solicit parental involvement in scholars' development of literacy and math skills the facilitator will be Principal, Delano Whitfield for question you may contact him at (501)985-1200.
- JLCS will create a website that contains links to faculty's individual web pages by Lisa Clay 508.626.0901.
- Parents will be able to access their scholar's grade information through PowerSchool, and by contacting faculty directly via email by September 12, 2011
- All JLCS Teachers will send home daily agendas, as well as weekly folders or – in the case of scholars in grades 5-8 – interim report cards (issued every three (3) weeks). Parents will be required to sign agendas and progress reports and return them to their scholar's homeroom teacher. In addition, JLCS will provide parents with a report card four times a year.
- JLCS Teachers will routinely contact parents on an individual basis to communicate pertinent information about academic progress.
- JLCS will use ads in local media, a billboard in front of the school, and School Messenger memos to communicate with parents about school events in a timely manner. Mr. Delano Whitfield or Dr. Anderson (501) 985-1200.
- JLCS will distribute a Student-Family Handbook at the beginning of the school year; parents will be required to sign the handbook to indicate their acceptance of all policies therein. Return them to your child's teacher (501) 985-1200.

Section B: Designated Parent Meetings, Conferences, and Activities

- JLCS will host at least three (3) Parent Information Nights and one (1) Open House every August. These meetings will feature information about JLCS's Title I program.
- JLCS will designate a half day every quarter (12:00-4:15 PM) for parents to conference with teachers about their scholar's academic progress. October 28th, January 20th and April 6th. JLCS will also encourage and allow parents to attend academic conferences during the weeks immediately prior to and immediately after teachers have closed their grade books. These meetings will include a summary of scholar's test scores and an explanation of interventions being used (as necessary) to promote student achievement.
