Progress toward goals

Goal 1: All students will be prepared to achieve success in college.

- ✓ Results Year 1: Not Applicable

Goal 2: All students will contribute to at least one public art demonstration or performance each year.

- ✓ Results Year 1: JLCS held a Fine Arts Exhibit at the Thea Foundation in North Little Rock in which over 200 parents and community members attended to view Scholar's art and musical performances.

Goal 3: Parents will demonstrate satisfaction with the school's programming and operation.

- ✓ Results Year 1: JLCS received a 3.58 ranking our 4.0 in parent satisfaction

Goal 4: The school will demonstrate enrollment stability.

- ✓ Results Year 1: JLCS remained at full capacity all year. 96% of the scholars elected to reenroll. The average daily attendance was 97% and the school maintains a waitlist of 500 or more students.

- ✓ Results Year 1: 98 % retention of eligible teachers and received a 3.4 ranking in satisfaction with the mission and vision.

Goal 6: The school will be financially stable

- ✓ Results Year 1: JLCS completed the year with a balanced budget. A new 28,000 square foot school building was constructed.
